	The program started on 10/4/2021 with the first telehealth visit on 10/25/2021. There have been <b>1,767</b> total births, 262 ineligibles due to county of residence, and <b>1,505</b> eligible births.		
	567 closed cases, 48 completed visits but cases are not closed yet, 516 scheduled cases so far.		
	4C has hired 7 nurses and a prospect for the 8 <sup>th</sup> ! She will be part time in the meantime.		
	Preparing to go to in-person visits soon. This planning has started as well as planning for in person recruitment efforts.
