As of October 28, 2024, there were 888 slots in the Private Centers, 868 of those slots have been filled. There were 434 slots at CCS and 90 slots at Head Start. Each of those slots have been filled. There were 230 children on the waiting list who are waiting to be placed in the program.	None	None

Delivery	B.3. A barrier in the program, is that quality programs and teachers are needed to assist with getting children off the waiting list. Providers have completed additional ASQ training. PFC is going through Standards of Quality Training Certification. The next NC Pre-K Directors meeting is November 23, 2024 at PFC. Mary Sonnenberg reported that article that was released called "Is NC Pre-K Dying". Providers say that low funding makes it difficult. The article listed all the barriers that the committee has been discussing, such as staffing and losing sites. There has been a group convened by SAS who are looking at what kind of business model that could be put in place to sustain the NC Pre-K program.	None	None
